Calgary, Canada: The Alberta Mini Roadracing Association (AMRA) proudly accepted delivery of four CBR125R's this weekend from Riverside Honda, St. Albert, AB, Honda Powerhouse Dealer Pointe West Honda, Edmonton AB and Rocky Mountain Powerhouse in Calgary.

These four race machines will join AMRA's growing fleet of CBR125Rs. The first machine made race ready with a race kit donation from PMP, the four additional quadruplets will be prepped with Honda Powerhouse Dealer donated race kits. The Quadruplets will be ready to compete with Canadian National Mini Roadracing Associations' Bodhi Edie in the Parts Canada CBR125R Challenge commencing Round #3 June 25-28 at Calgary AB.

AMRA's league of youth racers who will each pilot a CBR125R's are chosen riders: Chris Wilson, 14 year old 2008 Spec Under 21 and Youth 10-16 Provincial Champion, KJ Gamblin, 16 year old 2008 Provincial / National Challenger and 2008 Formula GP and Formula Under 21 Provincial Champion 14 year old Emerson Lefurgey.
