

2010 Canadian National Mini Roadracing Championship Series – Round #2**Prepared by: Dawn Stearn & Kevin Ham**

Regina, Canada: On June 12/13, 2010 round 2 of the CMA sanctioned National Championship Series, produced an exciting weekend of motorsport in Saskatchewan. The event was hosted by the Prairie Sport Riders Association (PSRA – www.prairiesportriders.com), at their home track “3 Flags Motorsports Park”. With almost 60 race class entries representing mini roadracing clubs from across Western Canada, the PSRA’s team of local racers were keen to match their racing skills against the racers from visiting club’s.

The first class on the grid was the Thunder Class (Sponsored by Thunder City). As usual this class provided great excitement and continues to be popular with both racers and spectators. Kevin Ham (PSRA President) took the victory in race #1 at the close of an eight lap battle with AMRA’s Jay Baloch (Calgary). Race #2 saw these two racers jump to the front of the pack early in the race to resume their contest. With almost a photo finish, Baloch edged in front of Ham at the finish. Following close behind was one of the PSRA’s newest racers Maxx Ebenal riding on the Thunder City sponsored Kawasaki KLX.

This year’s youth category, ages 7-10, consisted of Brett Stitch, Jonathan Finn and William Brown. As usual, the youth class riders were anxious to get out on the track and make their parents proud. They all had big smiles on their faces and seemed to be very excited about racing against each other. Whether they won or not, the smiles stayed with them all day long. As always the Youth class was a crowd pleasing experience to watch as these future racing stars pushed their bikes to the limits. Congratulations to all three riders on a great race. In the end, victory went to Brett Stitch of Moose Jaw SK, taking first place followed by Jonathan Finn Bushell Park, SK in second and William Brown of Regina, SK in third. Seeing such dedication, competitiveness and sportsmanship from these young participants signals a bright future for mini roadracing.

A special feature of this event was the PSRA’s promotion of ladies in mini roadracing called the “We Can Do It” Ladies Invitational Race. The objective of the program was to introduce the exciting sport of mini roadracing to ladies that had never raced before. Ladies participating in the program were well prepared the races by attending several pre-event practice sessions and a track school. With the support of the PSRA, the ladies were provided with club bikes and racing equipment. Lining up at the grid in excited anticipation were 8 female racers ranging in age from 12 to over 40, including family race teams. As the name implied these ladies really could race and they thrilled the crowd on hand with plenty of passing and lead changes as the race progressed.
